


Clearing Cache on Firefox:



1. In the upper right, click on the 3 horizontal bars 
2. Select 'Options'
3. On the left hand side, click on 'Privacy & Security' or search for the word "clear"

4. Go to the 'Cookies and Site Data' section and click on the button 'Clear Data...'

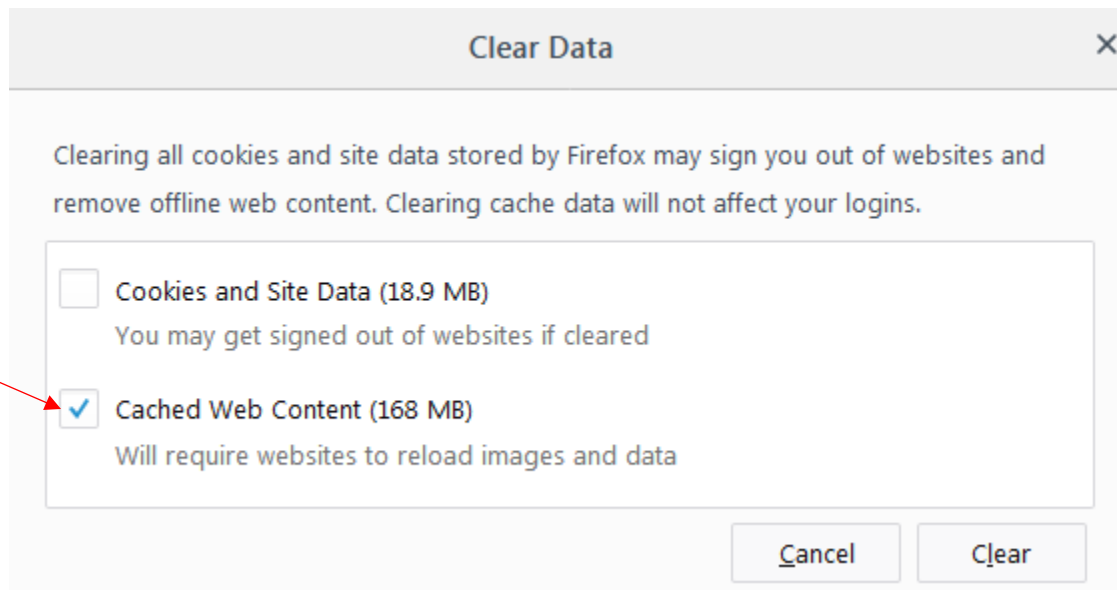

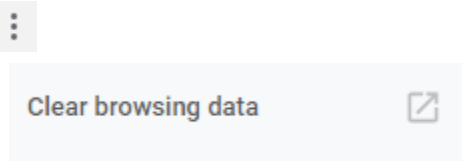

Clearing Cache on Google Chrome:



1. In the upper right, click on the vertical 3 dotted line
2. Select 'History' from the drop down menu
3. On the left hand side, click on 'Clear browsing data'
4. A box will pop up, and you need to make sure 'All time' is selected as the 'Time range'
5. All 3 of the boxes on the 'Basic' tab should be checked

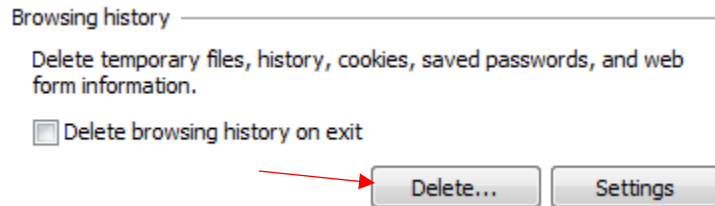

6. Click 'Clear data'

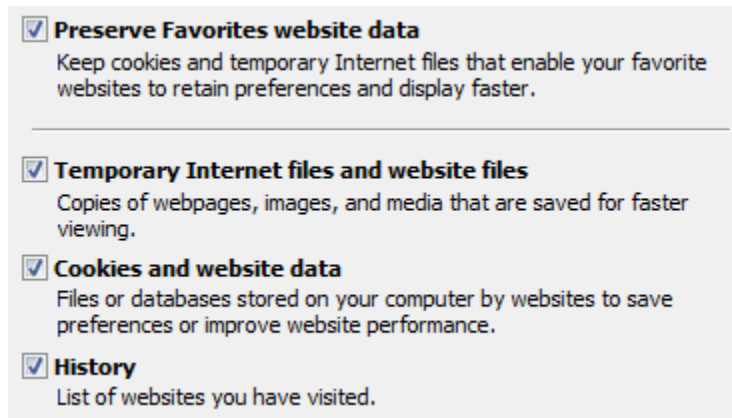
Clearing Cache in Internet Explorer:



1. Click on the gear icon in the upper right corner
2. Select 'Internet options' from the drop down menu
3. A box will pop up, and on the 'General' tab you will click on 'Delete...'



4. Make sure the first 4 boxes are checked



5. Click 'Delete'



Clearing Cache in Safari:



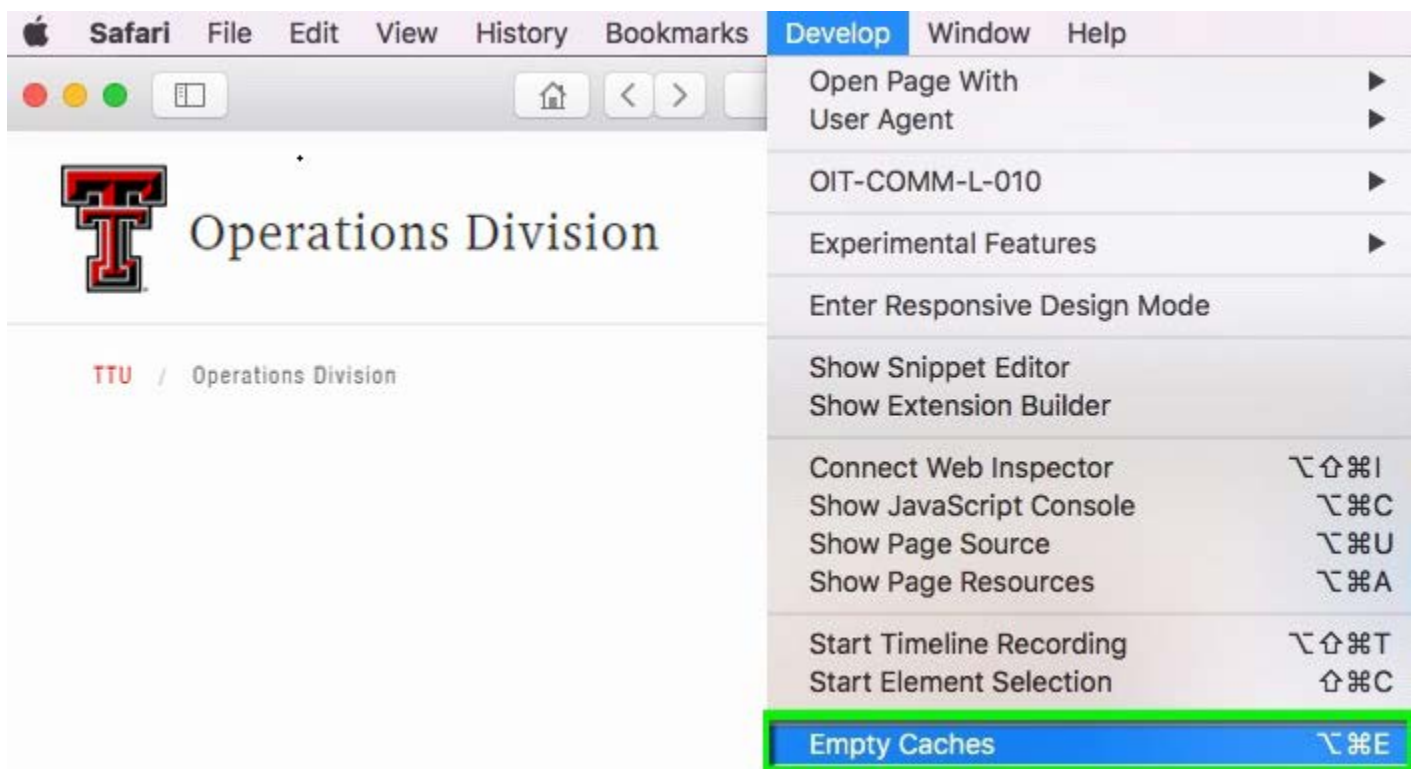
1. In the upper left, click on the 'Safari' drop-down menu and select 'Preferences'



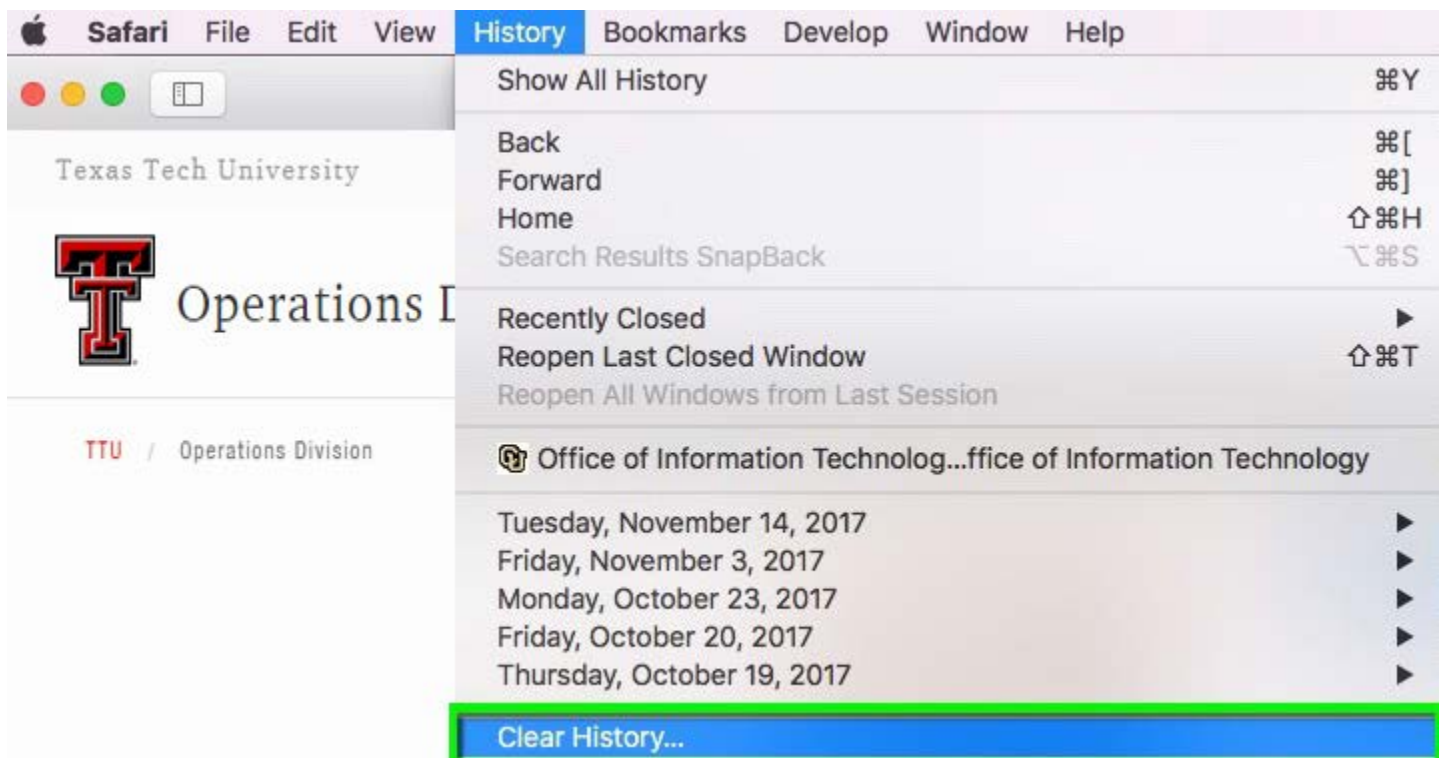
2. Click on the 'Advanced' tab. Select the 'Show Develop menu in menu bar' checkbox and close the Preferences window



3. Select the 'Develop' drop-down menu. Click 'Empty Caches'

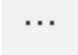


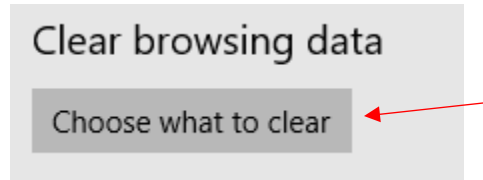
4. **Note:** You may want to also clear your browser history. Select the 'History' drop-down, then 'Clear History'



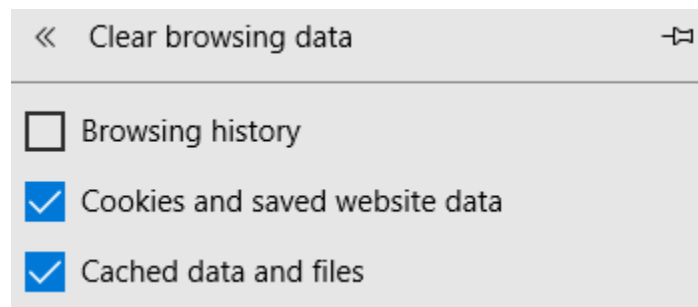
Clearing Cache on Edge:



1. In the upper right, click on the 3 vertical dots 
2. Select 'Settings' from the drop-down menu
3. Scroll down to 'Clear browsing data' and click on the button 'Choose what to clear'



4. Check the boxes, 'Cookies and saved website data' and 'Cached data and files'



5. Click on the button 'Clear'
