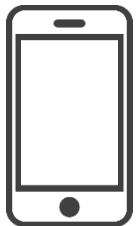
Information from Risk Intervention and Safety Education (RISE)





REQUIRED ONLINE PREVENTION EDUCATION

- Required for all incoming first year & transfer students
- Instructions and due date available at rise.ttu.edu
- Educates on alcohol safety, violence prevention, and campus resources



RISE is empowering Texas Tech students to live vital, meaningful lives through comprehensive prevention education

- **Title IX**

No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.

- Examples: Sexual Assault, Intimate Partner Violence, Stalking, Exploitation, Sexual Harassment

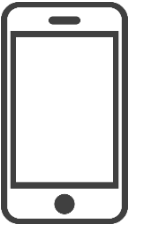

- **BLUE LIGHT PHONES**
 - 102 blue phones placed around campus
 - Direct line to the Texas Tech Police
- **TECHALERT!**
 - Communicates important alerts and emergency response information to students

- Use the TapRide app to request a ride every day from 6 p.m. to 2:45 a.m.
- Request your ride when ready to leave your location.
- Avoid canceling rides in an effort to increase or decrease wait time. Canceling a ride increases wait times for others requesting rides.
- Failing to show up for your ride results in not being able to request again that night.
- Excessive instances of canceling and no-shows result in suspension of use.

SAFE WAY HOME

▪ **Raider Ride**

- **Must use TapRide App**
- **Free shuttle when the starting or ending point of the trip is on the TTU main campus or satellite lots**
- **\$5 charge when the trip is from any off-campus location to another off-campus location**

▪ **Night Shuttle**

- **742-RIDE from 6:30 pm – 2:45 am**
- **If going on-campus to on-campus location**
