REQUIRED ONLINE PREVENTION EDUCATION


- Required for all incoming first year & transfer students

- Educates on alcohol safety, violence prevention, and campus resources


RISE is empowering Texas Tech students to live vital, meaningful lives through comprehensive prevention education





- Use the TapRide app to request a ride every day from 6 p.m. to 2:45 a.m.
- Request your ride when ready to leave your location.
- Avoid canceling rides in an effort to increase or decrease wait time. Canceling a ride increases wait times for others requesting rides.
- Failing to show up for your ride results in not being able to request again that night.
- Excessive instances of canceling and no-shows result in suspension of use.

Raider Ride

- Must use TapRide App
- Free shuttle when the starting or ending point of the trip is on the TTU main campus or satellite lots
- \$5 charge when the trip is from any off-campus location to another offcampus location
