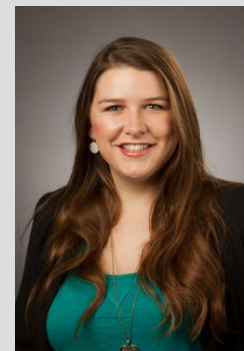

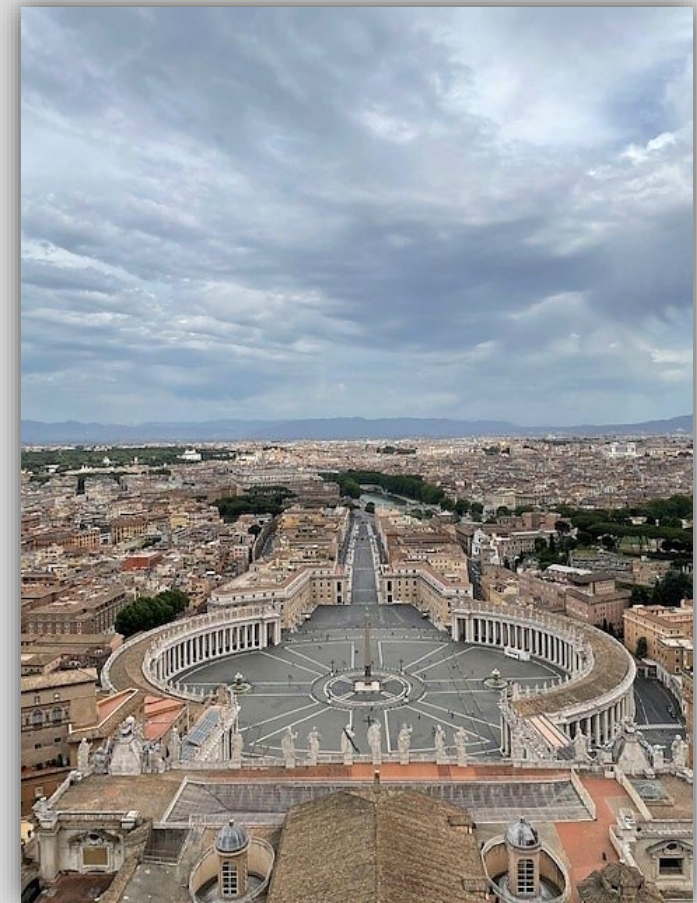

Who is Eligible?



- ✓ Must be at least 18 years old
- ✓ Must be a sophomore or above *by semesters*, not credits
- ✓ Must have a 2.0 GPA
 - 2.75 for Business students
 - 2.5 for Engineers
- ✓ Must be in good disciplinary standing with TTU

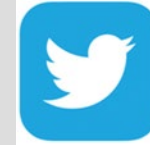
