

# Undergraduate Writing Center Services


- Writing consultations

- Online resources (videos, handouts)




### Three types (modalities) of consultations:






### Talk with your student about the UWC!

# When to recommend working with the UWC:

"I have an essay coming up!"

"I've never written an annotated bibliography/research proposal/lab report!"

"I've never used APA Style before!"

"I need to email my professor, but I don't know what to say!"

"I want to apply for graduate school/law school/medical school/a job!"

"I have a new assignment, and I don't understand what I'm supposed to do!"

"I received comments from my instructor, but I don't know what to do next!"

"I didn't do well on this assignment!"/"I did well on the assignment, and I want to do even better!"

"Will you help me with my writing assignment?"

### Talk with your student about the UWC!

# Help your student understand the UWC:

"I'm going to the UWC so they can fix my paper."

"I don't need to use the UWC because ChatGPT can write my papers for me!"

"I'm a good writer, so I don't need the UWC."

"I'm going into STEM, so I don't need the UWC."

"I don't need help; I already know this."

"I'm too busy to go to the UWC."

"I worked with the UWC once already, so I don't need to go back."

"I need help, but I don't want the writing consultants to judge me!"

"I've never been a good writer, so what's the point?

- Study Space, Computer Lab







### Supplemental Instruction (SI)

- Peer-led Review Sessions
  - Historically Difficult Courses, High DFW Rates
  - 2, 1.5-hour sessions per week (per course)
  - SI Leaders received "A" in course, audit course, work directly with faculty
  - Handouts (practice problems, concept reinforcement)
- Students who attend typically can raise grades by ½
  to full letter



# When to recommend working with LC/SI:

"I have questions, but I don't want to ask in front of everyone."

"I went to class, but I am still confused."

"I thought I was prepared for that exam, but I didn't do as well as I had hoped."

"I am so confused!"

"My professor's office hours conflicts with my other class."

"I just want to bounce some ideas off someone."

"I don't like studying on my own, I get distracted easily."

"I don't know which formula I should be using for this problem!"

"I wish someone knew what I was going through."

### Talk with your student about LC/SI!

# Help your student understand the LC/SI:

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"I haven't been to class in a week, the tutors can catch me up!"
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"I have a B already; I don't need any help."

"I have never been good in Math, so what's the point?"

"I was a straight A student in high school, I will be fine."

"I never had to study before, and I passed my classes."

"I can do this myself."

"If I get a bad grade, then I will go to tutoring."

"If there were only a place on campus where I can get help AND snacks!"

"Me + Chemistry = not good."
