#### Why Study Abroad?

- ✓ Pursue academics in another country
- ✓ Go above & beyond in degree
- √ Gain tangible skills for the future
- √ Enhance résumé
- Develop cultural understanding, independence, resilience and more





#### Key Career Benefits

- Alumni earn an average of \$6,000 more in starting salaries
- Nearly three quarters of alumni secured jobs within two months of graduation
- 52% of students attained graduate degrees after studying abroad

- ~1,000 Red Raiders abroad each year
- 200 programs in 50 countries
- 2 international TTU locations: Spain and Costa Rica
- Scholarships awarded annually

#### Who is Eligible?



- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must be a sophomore or above by semesters, not credits
- Must have a 2.0 GPA\*
  - 2.5 for Engineering students
  - 2.75 for Business students
  - \*Some programs require higher GPA
- Must be in good disciplinary standing with TTU





- Application completed online
- Students should be mindful of application deadlines
  - Plan ahead!





#### When to Study Abroad

- Students encouraged to begin planning early – ideally, during their first year
- Earlier is better than later more options!
- Studying abroad during last 30 hours requires approval from Dean of College



Academic Advisors help students plan the best time to go.


