All first-time students to Texas Tech are required to live on campus for two academic semesters (Fall-Spring).


This requirement includes traditional freshmen as well as transfer students.






OFF-CAMPUS ELIGIBILITY


- To live off campus, students must be approved for an off-campus exemption.
- All exemption requests <u>and</u> results must be completed prior to the contract start date for the current academic year (August 21, 2025).














Students now can choose their preferred move-in date and time via the Move-In Timeslots. The available options for move-in dates will be August 21-24, 2025.



TECH-IN TIMESLOTS


The Tech-In Timeslots offered by University Student Housing allow residents to select a designated date and time to move-in to their residence hall.
