


VISITOR PARKING

Weekdays from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.	Stop by a campus entry station for a free visitor ePermit and directions on available parking.	
Weekdays from 5:30 to 8 p.m.	Look for signs when parking. Some parking is free, some lots have an hourly cost, and some areas are reserved 24 hours per day.	
Weekdays after 8 p.m. and Weekends	Nearly all area reserved (employee) lots and all commuter lots are free to use. Avoid residence hall lots and spaces reserved 24 hours per day.	
Game Days	Contact the Red Raider Club for game-day parking options.

PURCHASING A PERMIT

New employees visit the TPS office for the first purchase. Students purchase online using these steps:

- 1. Have your eRaider login information, license plate or VIN, and, if living on campus, your housing assignment secured.
- **2.** Go to www.parking.ttu.edu and click My Parking in the top right corner then My Parking Account.
- 3. Select Texas Tech University eRaider Sign In.
- 4. If logging in for the first time, follow directions to create your account.
- **5.** Once you reach the dashboard, select *Buy Permit* in the *Registered Vehicles* tab.
- **6.** Follow the steps to select the term you need the permit and which permit you want. If your preferred permit is sold out, it will appear in the steps as a wait-list option.
- **7.** Pay for the permit by either paying online with a credit or debit card or by adding to tuition.


