- 1. Minutes for the meeting on 11/20/2002. Approved by consensus.
- 2. <u>Election of Chair for 2003.</u> David Lamp was elected by acclamation. Julie Thomas indicated interest in serving for 2004.
- COMS 1300. Fish moved and Clopton seconded that COMS 1300 be approved for Oral Communications and deleted from Individual and Group Behavior. Motion passed unanimously.
- ASCAP request for feedback. After discussion of the request for greater feedback on negative decisions, the Committee agreed it would be appropriate to develop specific reasons for negative decisions.
- 5. Coordinating Board order for evaluation of the Core Curriculum and rules for transfer of Core courses.
