



PRESIDENT'S DISTINGUISHED SCHOLAR OR ARTIST NOMINATION PACKAGE

The President's Distinguished Scholar or Artist Award is a designation recognizing and retaining mid-career faculty in support of continued scholarly or creative activity. To be eligible for nomination, faculty members must be at or above the rank of Associate Professor, Associate Professor of Practice, or Research Associate Professor and hold tenure or continuing appointment.

Nominee is at or above the rank of Associate Professor with tenure, **OR:**

Nominee is at or above the rank of Research Associate Professor with continuing appointment

The Nominator should collect all of the following required documents and ensure that they are inserted into this nomination package in the following order:

1. Nominator's letter of nomination (max 2 pages)
2. Letter from Nominee's department chair, school director, or area coordinator (max 2 pages)
3. Five letters of support from current/emeritus faculty external to Texas Tech (max 10 pages total)
4. Nominee's CV (max 10 pages)
5. Nominee's statement of intended continuation of productivity post-award (max 2 pages)

The Nominator must save the nomination package as a single PDF document and submit it to the Nominee's academic dean's office by November 1, 2025. Late submissions, incomplete submissions, and submissions that exceed the maximum page limit will not be considered.
