- 3. Five letters of support from current/emeritus faculty external to Texas Tech (max 10 pages total)
- 4. Nominee's CV (max 10 pages)
- 5. Nominee's statement of intended continuation of productivity post-award (max 2 pages)

The Nominator must save the nomination package as a single PDF document and submit it to the Nominee's academic dean's office by November 1, 2025. Late submissions, incomplete submissions, and submissions that exceed the maximum page limit will not be considered.
