The CGC seeks to support projects that develop educational programming beyond the classroom to examine issues broadly covered under the global challenge areas of population, resources, technology, information, economics, conflict and governance. The goal of such programming is to promote student awareness of and engagement in current global challenges as such challenges relate to their academic pursuits.
