- Teaching Scheduled Teaching, Non-credit Instruction Taught (as well as designation of CeL course)
- Scholarship/Research All sections: Artistic and Professional Performances and Exhibits, Contracts, Grants, and Sponsored Research, Intellectual Contributions, Intellectual Property, Presentations, Non-Sponsored Research

Outreach and Engagement

Learning Events and Sessions - includes:

- Ability to document the type of Learning Event, e.g. Workshop, Conference, Video
- · Ability to link Program/Project to existing Contract or Grant
- Ability to document if other TTU units or colleges contributed to the activity**

Other Engagement Activities - includes:

- Ability to document the type of Engagement Activity, e.g. Clinical, Policy Analysis, Consulting
- · Ability to link Program/Project to existing Contract or Grant
- Ability to indicate if Program/Project resulted in any scholarly products
- Ability to document if other TTU units or colleges contributed to the activity**

Engaged Scholarship Impact Statement - includes:

- Community Need or Societal Issues addressed, Community Partners involved, and Specific Target Audiences
- Activity or collection of Activities, Programs, Scholarship, Number of people involved
- Impact of your Activities, designed to highlight key metrics that address community need or societal issue

Annual Report Review

Distribution of Effort - Need to document how much Engagement work you're doing? This section now includes:

- Teaching Workload Percentage
- Research Workload Percentage
- Engagement Workload Percentage
- Service Workload Percentage
- Other/Admin Workload Percentage

**Be sure to communicate with your contributers to prevent duplication of engagement activity. We recommend the "owner" of the program/project create the documentation.

Data is automatically populated on the contributor's end to ensure everyone is given credit.
