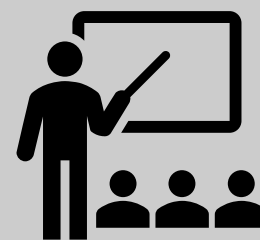
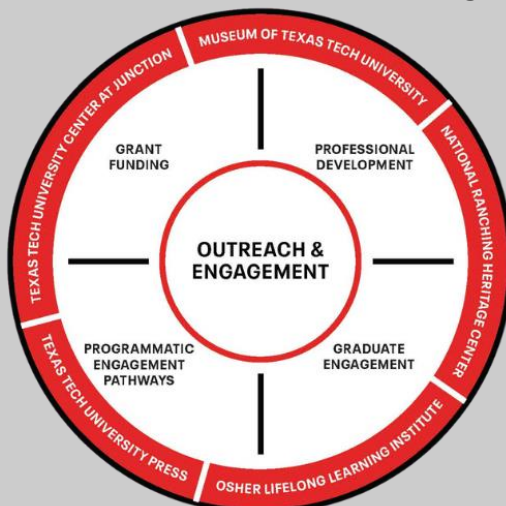
Programmatic Engagement Pathways (PEPs) for Faculty

Programmatic Engagement Pathways, or PEPs, are designed for seamless integration into faculty grant proposals, offering resources to enhance funding success such as:



Collaboration with community partners: identify partners and needs



Programmatic inquiry: develop a program evaluation plan (e.g. logic models, deliverables, theory of change)



Standardized evaluation: select measurement tools (e.g. rubrics, observation protocols, questionnaire)



Societal impact: quantify and demonstrate societal benefits
