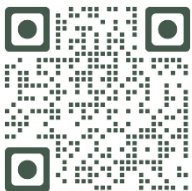

PGA FRISCO GOLF OVERVIEW



PGA of America has teamed up with Omni Hotels & Resorts, City of Frisco, and its Economic and Community Development Corporations, and Frisco ISD to build a world class Omni PGA Frisco Resort, private golf club and lifestyle destination in Frisco, TX.

Anchoring PGA Frisco are the new home to PGA of America's new state-of-the-art, 106,000 sq. ft. headquarters, along with Omni PGA Frisco Resort. and a multitude of other experiences and features within. The combined efforts of Omni Hotels & Resorts and PGA of America have laid the groundwork for PGA Frisco to foster a plugged-in, forward-thinking lifestyle experience-driven golf community that will lead the sport into the future.

The development features Fields Ranch East and Fields Ranch West championship golf courses, a par-3, 10-hole short course totaling 46 holes as well as a 2-acre putting course within the 660-acre property. Gil Hanse and Beau Welling were hand-selected to design Fields Ranch East and Fields Ranch West championship golf courses.



The facility has already hosted four televised championships and will host 22 additional championships through May 2034, including two PGA Championship events, and the KPMG Women's PGA Championship. Hanse designed the 7,800-yard Fields Ranch East course with smallish greens that artfully combine gentle undulations and stronger slopes, placing a premium on accurate approach shots. This course provides a dramatic setting for avid golfers.

Welling designed Fields Ranch West to offer a sense of community where players of varying skill levels can have a positive experience in a remarkable, naturalistic setting. Fields Ranch West spans 7,400 yards and has the highest elevation on the property, Fields Overlook, which showcases panoramic views across the PGA Frisco property.

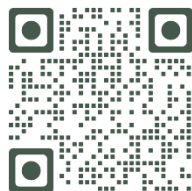
