### Position Description

Provide basic assistance to the TeCSIS- (Texas Coalition for Sustainable Integrated Systems Research) TAWC (Texas Alliance for Water Conservation) Program related to research activities at the Texas Tech New Deal Farm. Adherence to robust safety practices and compliance with all applicable health and safety regulations are responsibilities of all employees.

### Major Functions

- This individual will work with and under the supervision of the TeCSIS Unit Manager at the Texas Tech New Deal Farm with primary work activities assigned through the TeCSIS Program Manager and Program Director.
- Assist program graduate students, visiting scholars in project research and data collection.
- Activities will include operation of both large- and small-scale farm equipment, manual hand sampling, assist in repairs, maintenance, fertilizer and chemical applications, irrigation, and field harvesting as required to meet the program objectives.

- Texas Tech enrolled undergraduate student.

- Candidates who have previous farming experience.

- Student will be responsible for travel to and from the farm facilities located approximately 20 miles north-east of main campus and 6 miles east of the town of New Deal, Texas.
