FIN 3320	Financial Management. Prerequisite: ACCT 2300, ECO 2301, and minimum 2.75 TTU GPA. Prerequisite/Corequisite: ACCT 2301, ECO 2302, and MATH 2345. To declare Finance as a major student must make an A or B in ACCT 2300 and FIN 3320
ISQS 3344	Introduction to Production and Operations Management. Prerequisite: ISQS 2340, MATH 2345 and minimum 2.75 Tech GPA
MKT 3350	Introduction to Marketing. Prerequisite: ECO 2301 and minimum 2.75 Tech GPA
MGT 3370	Organization and Management. Prerequisite: Minimum 2.75 Tech GPA
MGT 3373	Managerial Communication. Prerequisite: ISQS 2340 and minimum grade of C in ENGL 1301 and 1302, and minimum 2.75 Tech GPA

FIN 3324	Investments. Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B
FIN 4328	International Finance. Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B and FIN 3323
FIN 4385	Senior Finance Seminar. Prerequisite: FIN 3320 with a minimum grade of A or B, senior standing and final semester FIN Majors only

FIN 4333	Real Estate Appraisal. Corequisite/Prerequisite: FIN 3332 or 3334 (Spring only)
FIN 4335	Real Estate Investments. Corequisite/Prerequisite: FIN 3332 (Spring only)
FIN 4336	Urban Land Development. Corequisite/Prerequisite: FIN 3332 or 3334
FIN 4382	Internship in Finance. Prerequisite: At least six hours of professional courses (excluding core courses), to be determined by Area faculty
