Prerequisite: ISQS 2340 and MATH 2345 and minimum 2.75 Tech GPA ISOS 3344 3350 Introduction to Marketing. Prerequisite: ECO 2301 and minimum 2.75 Tech GPA MKT 3370 Organization and Management. Prerequisite: Minimum 2.75 Tech GPA MGT Managerial Communication. Prerequisite: ISQS 2340 and minimum grade of C in ENGL 1301 and 1302, and minimum 2.75 Tech GPA MGT 3373

# MAJOR COURSES

### 24 HOURS - MINIMUM GRADES OF C ARE REQUIRED

The 21 hours must consist of four junior- or senior-level courses and three senior-level courses, not used to fulfill another requirement. These courses must be selected from the areas of ACCT, ECO, FIN, ISQS, MGT, and MKT, and there must be at least one course chosen from at least three of the six areas.

### Non-Business / Non-Economics Electives

6 Hours - MINIMUM GRADES OF D ARE REQUIRED

Courses can be taken in the Lower Division and are eligible for pass/fail.

### FREE ELECTIVES

9 Hours or enough to complete the 120-hour requirement – Minimum grades of D are required

These courses are eligible for the pass/fail option provided they are not major courses. Total pass/fail hours cannot exceed 13 hours.
