"A" or "B" in ACCT 2300, ACCT 2301, MATH 2345 or MATH 2300, and FIN 3320.

"C" or better in ISQS 2340.

MANAGEMENT

"A" or "B" in MGT 3370.

MARKETING

"A" or "B" in MKT 3350.

SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT

"A" or "B" in SCM 3353.

*all majors require at least a minimum cumulative 2.75 TTU GPA to apply (except where noted). Some majors have certificates that allow the student to focus on more specific coursework.

Certificates allow students to pursue a special area of interest that complements their major areas of study. The Rawls College certificate programs range from 9 to 15 credit hours (i.e., 3 to 5 courses). 
