The Accelerated Bachelor's-to-Master's in Finance program allows qualified Rawls College students to earn both undergraduate and graduate finance degrees in a cost-effective and timely manner. While working toward their Master of Science in Finance, students can count up to nine credit hours of approved graduate coursework toward their undergraduate degree, allowing them to graduate with both degrees in as little as five years.

Submit:

- Resume
- Official transcripts from all colleges, universities, and post-secondary institutions that you have attended
- GRE or GMAT scores (optional)
- Official proof of English proficiency for international students
- Two letters of recommendation
- One page essay outlining goals, personal experiences, past challenges, and any other relative information
