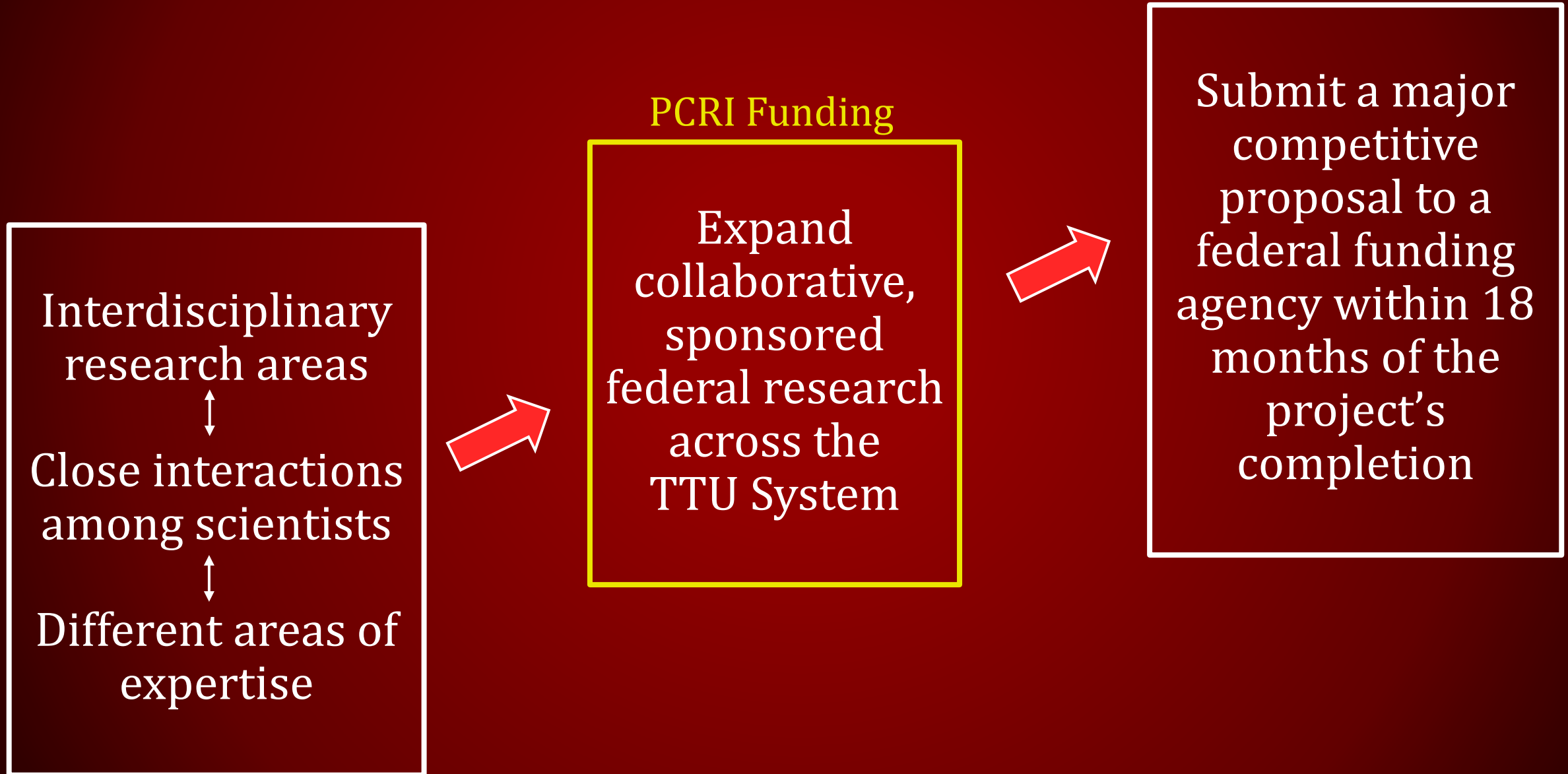


PRESIDENTS' COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH INITIATIVE

PURPOSE OF PCRI FUNDING



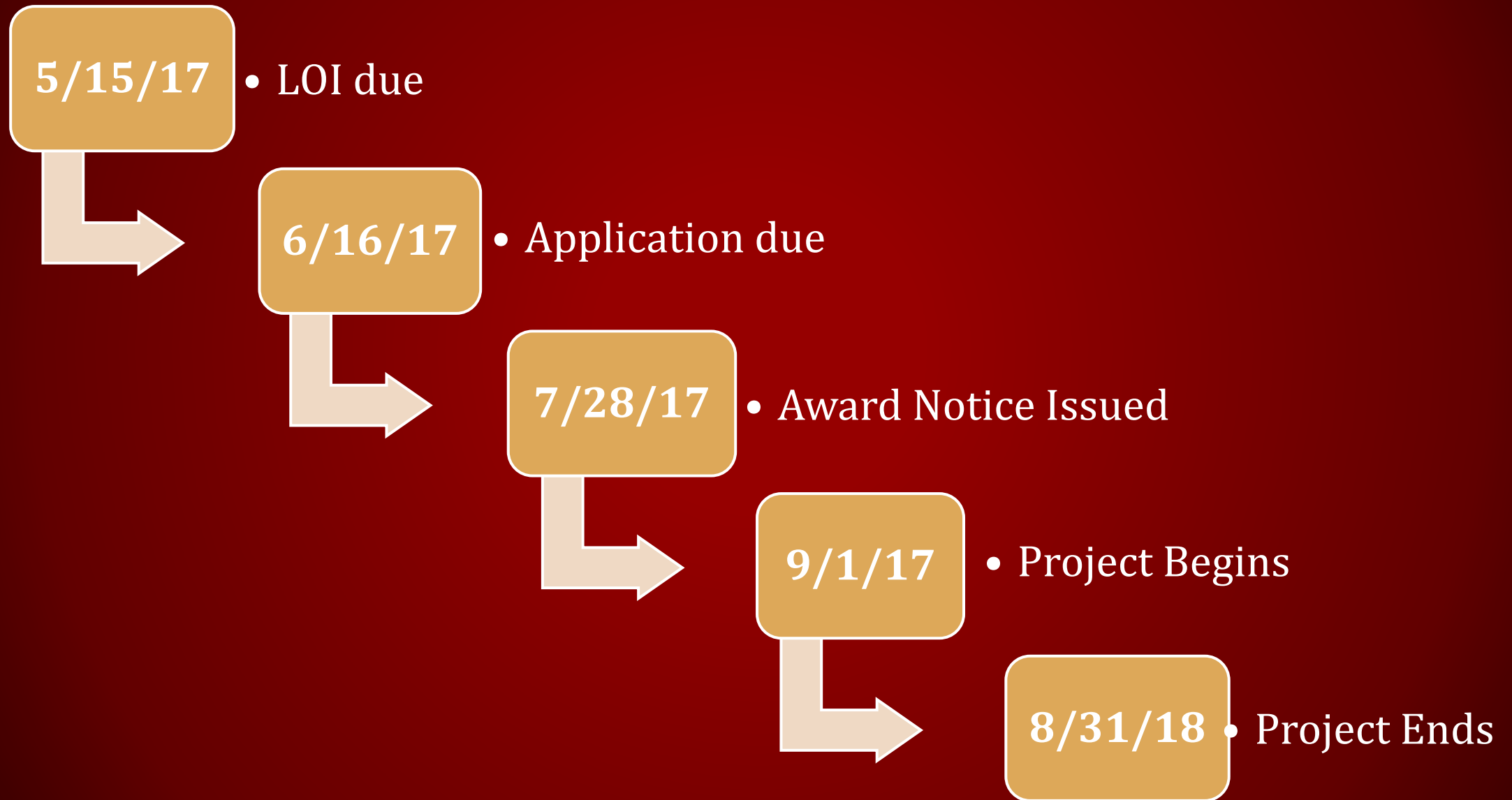
ELIGIBILITY

- The Principal Investigator (PI) must have a primary faculty appointment and more than 50% employment at TTU, TTUHSC, or TTUHSC El Paso
- Each PI/Co PI may only be funded by one award per funding cycle
- Applicants are ineligible to apply as a PI if they were awarded funding in the preceding cycle, but may serve as a collaborator
- Only those PIs that submit a LOI by the due date, and are deemed eligible, will receive an application for completion

PCRI GRANT FUNDING AT A GLANCE

Funding Amount	Up to \$50,000
Project Length	September 1, 2017 to August 31, 2018
LOI Due Date	May 15, 2017
Application Due Date	June 16, 2017
Allowable Budget Items	Salary support for existing research personnel, including post-doctoral fellows and students; equipment/supplies for proposed research; and travel (restricted to travel between campuses)
Extension allowed?	No

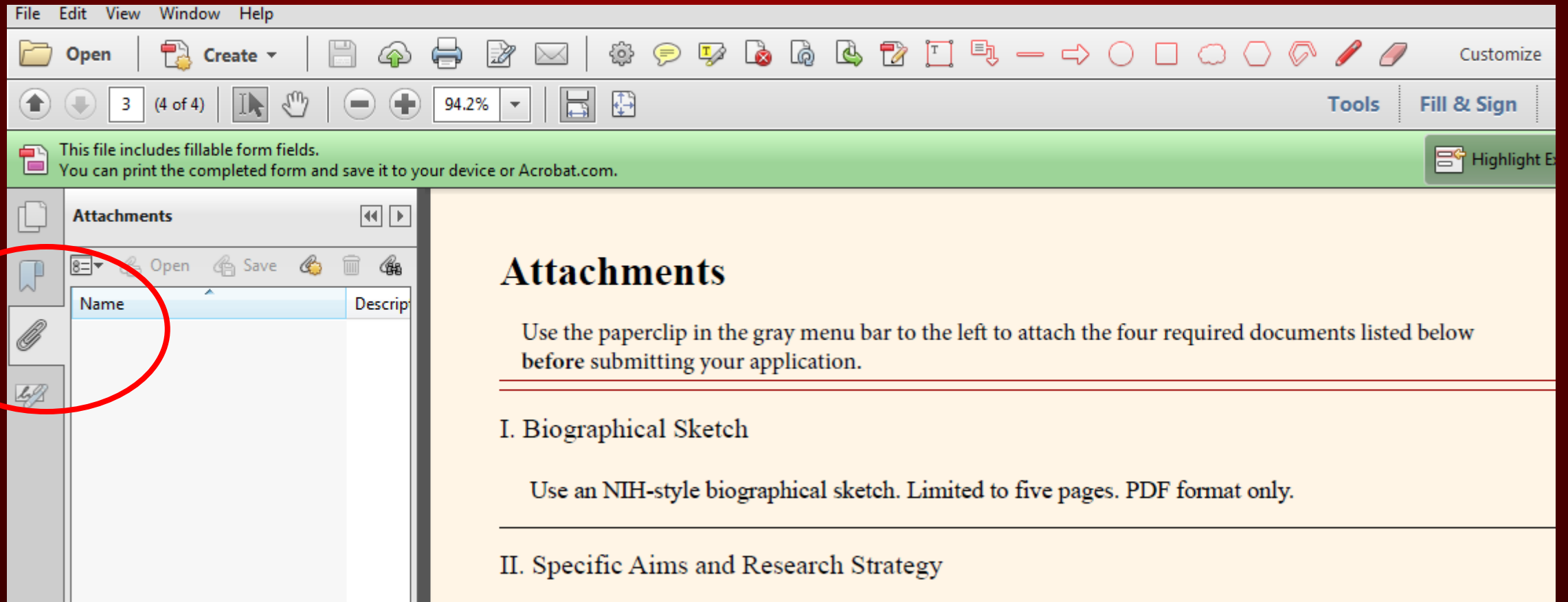
FUNDING TIMELINE



APPLICATION TIPS

- Read the guidelines before completing the application.
- Complete the application early in case you have any technical difficulties or questions. Late applications will not be accepted.
- Complete all required fields - answering yes to some questions makes additional fields required.
- Submit the application by clicking the submit button within the application form. Applications will not be accepted any other way.

Attach all documents within the application using the paperclip attachment button.

OTHER IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS

- Funding will not support or supplement current externally funded research. The applicant must clearly and convincingly show that the proposed project is a new research direction with the potential to lead to external funding.
- If using human or animal subjects in your research project, IRB and IACUC protocols must be submitted to the appropriate committee(s) for review before grant submission.
