Background:

When TTU submitted your new research proposal to the National Science Foundation (NSF), the University certified that it has a plan to provide education and training in the Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR).

Your responsibilities:

Our TTU plan requires you, as PI, to require **all** students (undergraduate and graduate) and postdoctoral trainees whose research is supported by your NSF award. See (new OVPR website) for more information.

Instructions:

As a Principal Investigator (PI) of an NSF-supported award, you must certify that **all** students and postdoctoral trainees whose research is supported by your NSF award have completed safety training (before) and on-line RCR training (within 30 days of days of joining the project). Submit the form electronically to ResearchIntegrity@ttu.edu and by paper to the OVPR, c/o Alice Young, within 90 days of your award and then annually on the anniversary date of the award for the duration of the project, updating any additions of students and postdocs since the last report and certifying the required training has occurred.
