SHINGLES DOESN'T CARE.

Even the healthiest lifestyle can't stop your immune system from declining as you age, increasing your risk of shingles. Over 99% of people 50 years and older have the virus that causes shingles already inside them. 1 out of 3 people will get shingles in their lifetime. Everyone age 50+ and certain people age 19-49 with a compromised immune system are eligible to receive shingles vaccine.

An estimated 14 million new HPV infections occur in the United States each year. Even if you've been infected with one type of HPV, it may not be too late to help protect yourself from certain cancers caused by other types of the virus. If you are age 11-45 years you may be eligible to receive HPV vaccine.
