SUBJECT: Open hearings on the proposed Faculty Senate

As you know, for approximately two years an ad hoc committee of the Faculty Council has been studying the question of revision of the Faculty Council Charter. The committee has recommended the replacement of the Faculty Council by a Faculty Senate, has written a proposed Constitution for the Faculty Senate and has submitted the recommendation and Constitution to the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee has, in turn, established a series of four open hearings to consider this question.

For your consideration, the document <u>Constitution of the Faculty Senate of Texas Tech University</u> is enclosed with this letter. It is anticipated that this document, or an amended version of it, will be presented to the Faculty Council at its Fall meeting on November 1, 1977, for its action.
