Resolution Reaffirming Support for Creation of a Child Care Liaison Position November 12, 2008

WHEREAS a resolution on the creation of a Child Care Liaison position was passed by the Texas Tech University Staff Senate, Faculty Senate, and Student Government Association during the Spring, 2008 semester; and

WHEREAS, to our knowledge, a Child Care Liaison position has not been created and filled; and

WHEREAS, the hiring of a Child Care Liaison would be a monumental step in the university's effort to support students, faculty, and staff and would enhance our ability to recruit highly qualified students, faculty, and staff; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate reaffirms its support for and urges creation of a Child Care Liaison position, to be filled as soon as possible; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate recommends that the Child Care Committee be involved in developing the PDQ (POSITION DESCRIPTION QUESTIONNAIRE) for this position; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be distributed to Chancellor Kent Hance, President Guy Bailey, members of the Texas Tech University System Board of Regents; the Vice President of Student Affairs and Enrollment Management; Interim Provost Jane Winer; the President of the Staff Senate; the President of Student Government Association, and the Editor of The Daily Toreador.
