COTTON v. STOVALL

ON PETITION FOR APPEAL CONCERNING THE TEXAS TECH UNIVERSITY ELECTION COMMISSION DECISION OF MARCH 3, 2013.

CHIEF JUSTICE ROLLO, with whom JUSTICE URYASZ, JUSTICE MEYER, and JUSTICE SCIOLI join, issues the opinion of the Court.

TO ALL PARTIES INVOLVED:

The full opinion of the Court to follow.

The Supreme Court of the Student Government Association of Texas Tech University has reached a decision in *Cotton v. Stovall* (2013-01). It is the opinion of the Court that the Election Commission's decision of March 3, 2013 should be REVERSED. The Election Commission is hereby commanded to reinstate the results of the election in regards to the Office of the President and the Office of the Vice President for Internal Affairs. Furthermore, since the violation of § 7.31 of the Election Code was not appealed, the Court hereby commands the Election Commission to proceed with a new election for the Office of the Vice President for External Affairs, in accordance with their prescribed guidelines.

The temporary restraining order on campaigning is hereby lifted, in accordance with this opinion.
