

TTU MSW TO ASW DSW

Enrollment into the D.S.W. program within the Department of Social Work and Sociology will be subject to the following ASU D.S.W. graduate admission provisions. The D.S.W. program is intended for students who earned a graduate social work degree (e.g. M.S.W., M.A.S.W., or M.S.S.W.) from a CSWE-accredited program or candidacy status program.

Students need to meet the following requirements:

Earn a graduate social work degree such as a M.S.W., M.A.S.W., or M.S.S.W. from a CSWE-accredited program or candidacy status program.

1. Earn a grade point average of 3.00 or higher in a Master of Social Work program from a CSWE-Accredited or candidacy status program and from a regionally accredited institution.
2. Complete and submit the ApplyTexas application for admission to the ASU Graduate School. After submitting the ApplyTexas application, students will receive an email with instructions on how to access the application to the D.S.W. program. Submit all official transcripts to the ASU Graduate School by the application deadline posted on the [Clinical Social Work D.S.W. Admission](#) webpage.
3. No GRE or letters of reference are required.
4. A social work license in any state at the master's level is preferred (e.g., LMSW, LCSW, LICSW, etc.) but not strictly required.
5. An essay (i.e., statement of purpose), written in APA format, covering their goals for the degree, career plans after graduation, and who you wish to be your major professor/advisor from the Department's tenured/tenure-track faculty.

Scholarships

TTU students are encouraged to complete their application for admission to the university and submit unofficial transcripts (if admitted, students will be required to send in official transcripts to ASU) as early as possible to be considered for the ASU Distinguished Graduate scholarships. Students applying for Summer or Fall semesters have a priority date of April 15th and Spring semesters have a priority date of November 15th. Students admitted to ASU before those dates will automatically be reviewed for the scholarship. Students admitted to ASU after those dates will be reviewed to the extent funds are available. As long as funds are available, scholarship amounts are based on the highest degree grade point average at the time of admission and are renewable based on award criteria.
