* Only **44%** of adults and children actively think about the consequences of their online activities on how other people see them.

* Only **38%** think about the effect their online activities may have on the reputations of others. 8 things NOT to do online

- 1. Post illegal activities
- 2. Post negative comments about your teachers, bosses, colleagues or companies
- 3. Post confidential information
- 4. Lie
- 5. Threaten violence
- 6. Rely 100% on privacy settings
- 7. Post emotionally
- 8. Create an unprofessional/ irresponsible profile
