

## TTU Important Dates – Fall 2020

July 24, Friday

- Fee Assessment Occurs for Fall 2020 (Charges Available for viewing if Registered for Classes)

July 27, Monday

- Budget Payment Plan available for enrollment

July 31, Friday

- Deadline for transcripts for transfer students entering Fall 2020 to be considered for Transfer Merit Scholarships

August 12, Wednesday through September 18, Friday

- Book loans available – must be re-paid by September 25, Friday

August 14, Friday

- Emergency Payment Plan available for enrollment
- Financial Aid Disbursed for Fall

August 17, Monday

- TTU - payment deadline. Registration changes made after this date could affect the student's account balance, and must be paid immediately unless the student is enrolled in a Fall Payment Plan

August 18, Tuesday

- Financial Aid refunds begin

August 24, Monday

- TTU Classes begin

September 7, Monday

- Labor Day. University holiday

September 9, Wednesday

- Last business day to **WITHDRAW** in the Registrar's Office for a full refund. See below for the full schedule of withdrawal dates and refund percentages
- Last day to **DROP** a course and receive a refund. Does not apply to students who drop to 0 hours. Dropping to zero hours in a term is considered withdrawing from the semester and must be done through the Registrar's Office. Please see more details below on the Withdrawal Process.

If a student chooses to **withdraw** from the university, they will need to complete the withdrawal process through the Registrar's Office (room 103 West Hall). Withdrawal dates for Fall 2020:

Up through September 9 -100% refund  
September 10 through September 21 - 50% refund  
September 22 and after- No refund

- Book Loan due date

October 1, Thursday

- 2021-2022 FAFSA opens
- University Competitive Scholarship Application opens

October 25, Sunday

- Budget/Emergency/Military Payment Plan due date – Required payment must be received by the due date or the account will incur late fees

November 5, Thursday

- Advance Registration Begins for Spring 2021/Summer 2021

November 24, Tuesday

- Last day for student-initiated drop on MyTech with academic penalty (counts against drop limit). **All drops are the responsibility of the student.**
- Last day to withdraw from the university. Although withdrawal can be processed until this date, all tuition and fees related to the registration are due in full and no refunds will be issued.

November 25, Wednesday

- Budget/Emergency/Military Payment Plan due date – Required payment must be received by the due date or the account will incur late fees

- Last day to withdraw from the university. Although withdrawal can be processed until this date, all tuition and fees related to the registration are due in full and no refunds will be issued.

November 25 – November 29, Wednesday – Sunday

- Thanksgiving holiday. No meals available at any Hospitality Services location. University employees will not be on duty November 25-29.

December 1, Tuesday

- Priority Deadline for University Competitive Scholarship Application for students who will enter Texas Tech as freshmen in the 2021-2022 academic year

December 2, Wednesday

- Last day of classes

January 5, 2021 Tuesday

- Deadline for transcripts for transfer students entering Spring 2021 to be considered for Transfer Merit Scholarships

April 15, 2021, Thursday

- Deadline for transcript and test scores for students who will enter Texas Tech as freshmen in the 2020-2021 academic year to be considered for Presidential Merit Scholarships
