#### TRANSFER AMBASSADOR MISSION

Transfer Ambassadors support transfer students in their transition to Texas Tech and aid them in making friends, getting involved, and building leadership skills. Transfer Ambassadors contact incoming students prior to their orientation session, connect with students at orientation, and continue to provide support during the academic year with on-campus activities and peer mentorship. The ideal Transfer Ambassador understands the unique needs of transfer students and is committed to helping new transfer students make a smooth transition from their transferring institution to life at Texas Tech.

### **CHARACTERISTICS OF TRANSFER AMBASSADORS**

- Strong interpersonal skills and communication skills, both written and verbal
- Desire to develop leadership skills and to engage in thoughtful self-reflection
- Positive attitude and energy
- Sense of humor and an ability to be flexible
- Genuine concern for others and desire to help fellow students and team members
- Enthusiasm for Texas Tech and the opportunities available to students

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Be enrolled as an undergraduate student during Spring 2024, Fall 2024, and Spring 2025
- Be in good academic and disciplinary standing with Texas Tech University
- Be a transfer student
- Maintain a minimum 2.5 Texas Tech GPA
- Ability to lift twenty-five (25) pounds for lifting boxes & materials

- Make a difference in the lives of incoming transfer students and play an important role in helping them make a smooth transition to life at Texas Tech
- Develop leadership and interpersonal communication skills
