



Red Raider Showcase Rules and Regulations

The following Rules and Regulations are to provide the act and all group members with guidelines to prevent disqualification. If any of these Rules or Regulations are broke, the act will be disqualified.

- All applicants must be currently enrolled at Texas Tech students
- You may perform covers, but all credit must be given to the original artist
- No inappropriate or profane lyrics or dancing will be allowed. Any lyrics or dances deemed inappropriate will result in disqualification.
- All applications must be submitted by Thursday, October 1st by 5:00 pm.
- Costumes, equipment, instruments, music, and props must be present on the day of Rehearsal or they will not be allowed to be used for the final performance.
- The act performed on the day of Rehearsal should be performed exactly as it will be for the final performance – including all costumes, props, equipment, instruments, music, and group members.
- If you require any props that could be considered weapons, the act will need to be approved by the Student Union & Activities Associate Director, Claire Nevarez. Please email Colin Owens Student Activities Board Coordinator at colin.m.owens@ttu.edu with any questions or concerns.

Provided Equipment

As this will be a 100% virtual show, all contestants will be required to provide all of their own equipment. A microphone and video capable device will be required for the show.

Judging

Judging will be based on the criteria of showmanship, technique, and originality.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at Red Raider Showcase, on November 12, 2020 to first place and second place winners.

- Prizes will be announced at a later date.

Limitations

The Student Activities Board (SAB) is a Texas Tech University organization so please keep in mind that all acts represent both SAB and Texas Tech University. All acts should adhere to The Code of Student Conduct. Please note that SAB reserves the right to have final say and end any performances that are deemed inappropriate.
