Apply for Dance Major

Apply for admittance to the dance major program, attending the on-campus audition or submitting a virtual audition, through Acceptd: <https://app.getacceptd.com/ttutd>. Upload your resume, headshot, technique videos (virtual auditions only), 1-minute solo, and a statement of purpose that describes your interest in dance, the degree program you are applying to (BA, BFA), and future career goals. Students will not be charged an application fee on Acceptd.



Apply for Dance Minor

Apply for admittance to the dance minor program, attending the on-campus audition or submitting a virtual audition, through this online form: <https://forms.office.com/r/3lkQzuvHLR>. Students will need to submit a headshot and technique videos (virtual auditions only). There is no application fee to apply to the dance minor.



Apply for MA Dance Studies

Apply for admittance to the MA Dance Studies Summer 2025 cohort, submitting an application to the TTU Graduate School Application Portal: <https://ttugradschool.force.com/admissions/ApplicationLogin>. Students will need to submit undergraduate transcripts, two letters of recommendation, CV/resume, academic writing sample of 5-10 pages, and a statement of purpose that describes your academic, artistic, and/or professional interests and goals specific to the online graduate program. Submit your application materials by January 1, 2025.




