WHY DOES TECH HAVE **CARE COORDINATORS?**

- To support & empower students in the aftermath of trauma
- To connect students to supportive measures
- To inform students about reporting options
- To help students navigate the formal grievance process

WHO DOES A CARE COORDINATOR WORK WITH?

Any individual referred to the Office for Student Civil Rights and Sexual Misconduct

We serve all genders, identities, and sexual orientations

WHAT DOES A CARE COORDINATOR DO?

- · Discuss reporting options, the Title IX investigative process, rights, responsibilities, and remedies
- Connect you with supportive measures (housing, counseling, safety concerns, academics, etc)
- · Provide support through being a safe listening space, staying in communication, and offering ongoing assistance

WHAT DOES A CARE COORDINATOR NOT DO?

- Make a formal report disclosing names and identifying information
 - Unless you specifically request this action
- Participate in the formal grievance process in any role other than a support person
