

Use of Audio/Visual Recording Devices

Lectures, discussions, and instruction in a Texas Tech classroom may not be recorded via audio and/or visual means without prior permission from either the instructor or SDS, with prior notice to the instructor.

Such permitted recordings are limited to legitimate academic purposes and cannot be shared with or distributed to any other person in any form without instructor approval. Students registered with Student Disability Services (SDS) *may* have an approved accommodation as documented on an SDS Letter of Accommodation that allows the student to record the class for their personal use to review course material.

Texas Tech faculty are entitled to copyright protection for their class materials and lectures, and unauthorized recordings may violate the faculty's copyright rights. Further, unauthorized audio and/or visual recording of academic classes may compromise the privacy rights of other students.

Violation of this policy may subject a student to discipline under the Texas Tech Code of Student Conduct.



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
