Resources for hybrid and online learning: How to insert a video hosted on YouTube or Vimeo into an "Item" in Blackboard. (Updated 1-2021)

TO EMBED A VIDEO INTO AN ITEM:


1. Copy the "embed code" from the video you want to insert. (Go to your video and select share, then click embed to copy the link.)
2. Select Build Content | Create | Item to reveal:

For the toolbar, press ALT+F10 (PC) or ALT+FN+F10 (Mac).



4. Click the ... if you don't see the full toolbar.
5. Click the brackets < > to reveal:

6. Paste your embed code as your line 2. (Insert your cursor after the end of line on and press return. It will insert the "2 line" and look like my example, but with your video's details.)
You won't need to worry about any of the code here, that's what you copied in Step 1.



7. Click save to reveal your video in the item.
(But, maybe yours won't have a goofy thumbnail graphic?)
