OUR FACILITIES

Amarillo Campus is the academic headquarters for our School. The facility includes all of the classrooms, teaching laboratories, and student support areas you need to succeed. It also includes abundant state-of-the-art research laboratories. Mariposa Station is located two miles northwest of the Amarillo Campus and is designed for hands-on instruction with all domestic livestock, including horses. The facility includes: an arena, equine and bovine skills laboratories, animal housing, a classroom, and more.

SELECTION PROCESS

Our School uses a holistic process that takes into account each applicant's life experiences and personal attributes relative to our School's purpose to serve rural and regional communities. The Admissions Committee evaluates the information applicants submit as part of their primary and secondary materials, as well as the interview process. Interviews are conducted in-person at the School of Veterinary Medicine's Amarillo Campus. Successful applicants are notified by February and must confirm acceptance by April 15th each year.

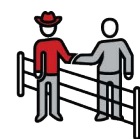


LIFE IN AMARILLO

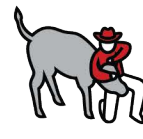

## THE FUTURE OF VETERINARY MEDICINE HAS ARRIVED

Working with the veterinary profession, the Texas Tech University School of Veterinary Medicine in Amarillo was established in 2018 to produce competent and confident practice-ready graduates. School of Veterinary Medicine students enjoy state-of-the-art facilities, and an interactive program that provides hands-on clinical learning in real-world settings.

## OUR PURPOSE

Our purpose as a School is simple. We serve the veterinary educational and service needs of rural and regional communities, and provide access to affordable, world-class education. Period.



## ACCREDITATION

In March 2021, our School was granted the status of Provisionally Accredited by the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) Council on Education (COE).

The next step in the accreditation process occurs in 2025 when the inaugural class is in their final year. At that time, we will request the status of full accreditation.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students must:

- > Complete the primary application through the Texas Medical & Dental Schools Application Services (TMDSAS) portal
- > Submit your secondary application. This application is sent by invitation only.
- > Be a Texas or New Mexico resident
- > Meet a 2.9 minimum overall GPA and 2.9 science GPA
- > Complete 48 Semester credit hours and 2 years of post-secondary instruction (after graduating high school) at a regionally accredited institution
- > Submit 3 evaluation forms, one of which must be from a veterinarian

We do not set a minimum number of hours of animal experience. However, the Admissions Committee critically assesses the hours of experience for quality related to the purpose and mission of our School.



## APPLICATION TIMELINE:
