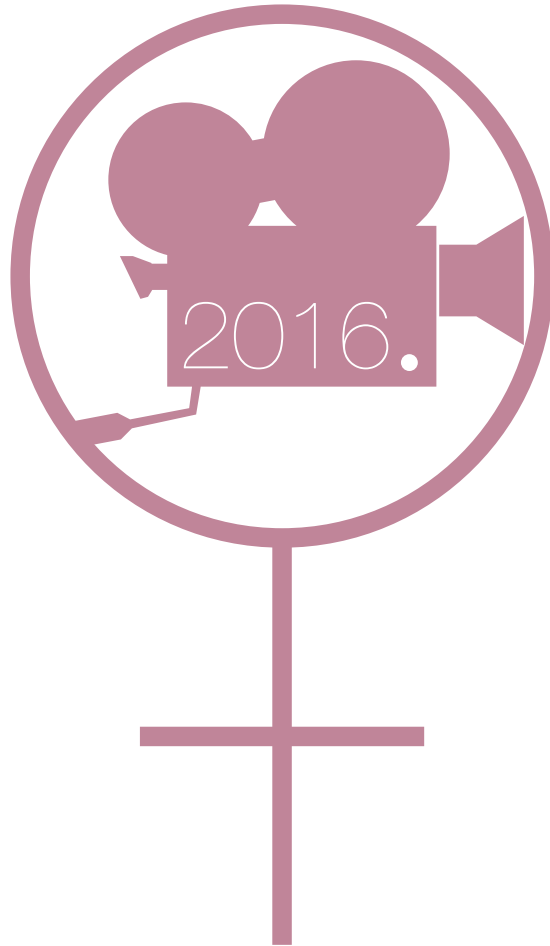


Sexism | Cinema

50 Years on the Silver Screen

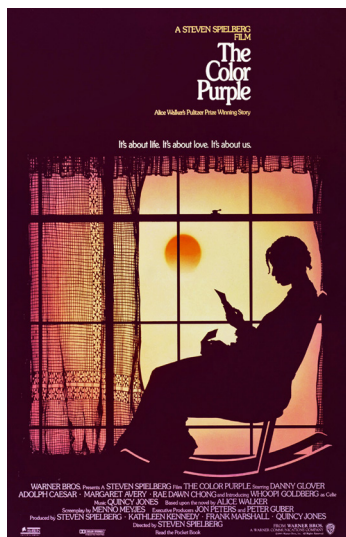

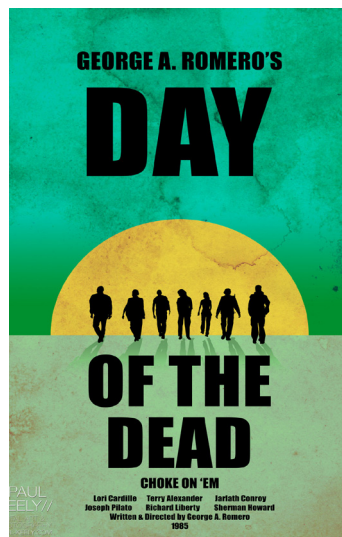
